- (2) Any person who browses and makes use of the Website (“**you**” and “**your**”).

1. Definitions and interpretation

In this Agreement, the words and expressions set out below shall have the following meanings:

Cookie: a cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer’s hard drive.

2. Information about our use of cookies

2.1 Our Website uses Cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Website and also allows us to improve our Website. By continuing to browse our Website, you are agreeing to our use of Cookies.

2.2 We use functionality/targeting Cookies on our Website. They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Website when they are

using it. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

2.3 You can find more information about the individual Cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

| _ga | Used to distinguish users | Expires after two years |
| _gid | Used to distinguish users | Expires after 24 hours |
| _gat | Used to throttle request rate. If Google Analytics is deployed via Google Tag Manager, this cookie will be named <code>_dc_gtm_<property-id></code> | Expires after 1 minute |
| AMP_TOKEN | Contains a token that can be used to retrieve a Client ID from AMP Client ID service. Other possible values indicate opt-out, inflight request or an error retrieving a Client ID from AMP Client ID service | Expiration can last between 30 seconds to 1 year |
| _gac_<property-id> | Contains campaign related information for the user. If you have linked your Google Analytics and AdWords accounts, AdWords site conversion tags will read this cookie | Expires after 90 days |
| mplk | MemberPress creates a cookie temporarily to allow the authorized user to view the file without being redirected. This cookie contains a random alpha-numeric string of text and is removed after 5 seconds. | Expires after 5 seconds |
| Cookies related to the Hubspot CRM | More information on individual cookies at https://knowledge.hubspot.com/reports/what-cookies-does-hubspot-set-in-a-visitor-s-browser | Expires after a maximum of 2 years |
| Cookies related to the Cloudflare CDN and firewall | More information on individual cookies at https://support.cloudflare.com/hc/en-us/articles/200170156-Understanding-the-Cloudflare-Cookies | Expires after a maximum of 2 years |
